Money Makes the World Go Round



<p>Designer Glasses</p> <p>Use materials you have at home to design a stylish pair of sunglasses or glasses. How much would you sell your glasses and why?</p>	<p>Advertisement</p> <p>Create a poster of your favourite chocolate bar or food. Try to make it stand out so people will want to buy it too.</p>	<p>Measurement</p> <p>Learn about measuring by helping bake or cook at home.</p>	<p>How much is...</p> <p>Go around your house to guess how much things cost. Go and ask your big people if you were right?</p>
<p>Entrepreneur</p> <p>Imagine something you could make or create to sell at a market. Draw what it would look like and write about how it would be used.</p>	<p>Heads or Tails?</p> <p>You need two players (or more). Flip a coin up in the air, catch it and put it on top of your hand. Guess whether it is 'heads' or 'tails'. Best out of 10 – wins!</p>	<p>Shop Owner</p> <p>Create your own shop using 'stuff' around the house. What would you price your items and why? Tell your big people why.</p>	<p>Super Saver</p> <p>Save your whānau money by listing all the things that you think you don't really need. Write down your reasons and have a talk with your whānau.</p>
<p>Sorting it Out!</p> <p>You will need a lot of coins. Put them all in one pile. Now you will have to sort them into the same coins. Get someone to time you. Start again and try to beat your time.</p>	<p>Money Detective</p> <p>Grab a few coins. Hide them around the house. See if your family can find them. Give them clues if they can't find them.</p>	<p>Coin Toss</p> <p>You need at least two players with the same number of coins. You must be at least a metre from the wall. Everyone must start their throw at the same place. You need to throw your coin as close to the wall as possible. The person who gets their coin closest to the wall gets to keep the coins thrown. Winner collects all the coins.</p>	<p>Shopping Planner</p> <p>Help your big people plan a shopping list for the next time they go to the supermarket.</p>
<p>Designer Note</p> <p>Have a look at some paper money. Design and create your own \$200 note. Who will be on your note?</p>	<p>Guesstimation</p> <p>Write a shopping list of things that you need. Write how much you think it costs. Ask your big people at home if you were right?</p>	<p>Meal Planner</p> <p>Work out a meal plan for your whānau and research how much money you will need for shopping that week.</p>	<p>Big Spender</p> <p>You have \$100 in your wallet. What would you buy and why? Draw or write down your items with an explanation.</p>
